What is it?

The Cricut EasyPress heats up to 400° for transferring images and iron-on (heat transfer) vinyl designs. The heat press can be used to customize bags, t-shirts, hats, mugs, and more!

What can I do?

You can customize a variety of fabric materials like canvas bags and t-shirts.

- A hot pad

What do I need for the Cricut EasyPress?

- A base material (t-shirt, canvas bag, pillow case, etc.)
 - Avoid synthetic fabrics that can melt
- A design created with the Cricut machine using iron-on (heat transfer) vinyl.

Iron-On (Heat Transfer) Vinyl

Iron-on (heat transfer) vinyl is long lasting.

- Designs must be cut with the [Cricut](#) machine.
- Recommended to wash cold inside out and to line dry or tumble dry low.
